POSITION TITLE/ NEED PERIOD	DESCRIPTION
Youth Mentors (Girls/Boys)	EFCS mentors serve as individuals who want to have a positive impact on young adults' lives. He/she is a trusted person who is caring and provides positive solutions and support.
Year-round	Mentors provide access to people, places, and things outside the mentee's daily routine and environment. The mentor uses a Life Plan, a written statement of the goals of the youth, as an ongoing touch point for mentoring relationships with our youth.
	Commitment: Meet in-person or virtual with assigned mentee(s) for a minimum of four (4) hours per month during weekly program sessions. Additional contact each month by phone or e-mail is also allowed, as needed.

Year-round	topics to support youth or adult program participants. Topics include but are not limited to career panel discussions or events, wellness, financial management, civic engagement, etc.
